

PET RULES

1. There is a charge of £30, £40 or £50 - depending on size - per pet per week (or per booking if staying for less than a week.)
2. Pets are only allowed in the areas with tiled floors – which means that in Gadlas they cannot go upstairs to the lounge.
3. Pets must not be left in the cottages on their own.
4. Owners should bring their pets' baskets for them to sleep - as they are not allowed on the furniture.
5. Pets are not allowed in the communal playing area – this is for the safety and comfort of all guests staying at both cottages.
6. ALL fouling must be cleared up immediately.
7. They are solely your responsibility.
8. When out in the countryside please ensure that your pets do not disturb/pester farm animals.

We respectfully ask you to keep pets off furniture and carpeted areas due to the increasing number of enquiries by people suffering from pet related allergies.

Please understand the conditions are there to try and safeguard everybody's comfort - and while your pet might be in the running for "best behaved pet of the year" - the next person's pet might not be! Also, being farmers ourselves makes imposing these conditions all the more important for us.
